A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE REQUEST FOR STATE FUNDING FOR GOLDEN VALLEY ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, THE DENALI BOROUGH, AND THE DENALI BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A GREENHOUSE THROUGH THE ALASKA ENERGY AUTHORITY RENEWABLE ENERGY FUND

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly supports the use of excess energy to develop and maintain projects and services that will benefit the residents and businesses within the Denali Borough and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly is aware that Golden Valley Electric Association has received renewable energy grants in the past and has successfully completed projects within the allotted time and budget: and,

WHEREAS, support of this study may increase educational opportunities for local students and adults and will also extend well past the Denali Borough boundaries to stimulate productive goods and services as well as research for future sustainable facilities within Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of a successful greenhouse project will also positively impact the delivery of goods and resolve some transportation issues while creating jobs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly hereby endorses and supports the request for funding through the State of Alaska's Renewable Energy Fund for purposes of a feasibility study for a greenhouse near the Golden Valley Power Plants in Healy, Alaska for the purposes of designing and building a greenhouse which will utilize excess energy from the power facilities.
