AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CHAPTER 3.25.020, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE OVERNIGHT
ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Denali Borough Code Chapter 3.25.020 as follows:

3.25.020 Imposition of overnight accommodations tax.

The borough levies a tax on the use and privilege of renting overnight accommodations within the borough equal to ~~seven~~ nine percent of the daily rate charged for each overnight accommodation rented for each 24-hour period, or any portion of that period. This tax is imposed upon all overnight accommodation rentals unless the rental is specifically exempted by other applicable law. The tax will not be imposed upon a permanent resident of a facility offering overnight accommodations of upon a person who works and lives in the same facility which offers overnight accommodations.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective on January 1, 2008 if it has been adopted by the Denali Borough Assembly, signed by the Mayor, and approved by a majority vote at the regular election to be held in November 2006.
