A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH
MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough recognizes the threat that local natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation projects before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of FEMA grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan has been sent to the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency for their preliminary approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Denali Borough Assembly, hereby adopts the Denali Borough Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Denali Borough will submit the adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.
