

**DENALI BOROUGH, ALASKA  
RESOLUTION NO. 07-12**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXCHANGE MUNICIPAL ENTITLEMENT LAND WITH THE CITY OF ANDERSON TO FACILITATE THE NEW CITY OF ANDERSON SEPTAGE FACILITY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Anderson and the Denali Borough are entitled to municipal land under the provisions of AS 29.65; and

WHEREAS, the City of Anderson and the Denali Borough have selected and acquired municipal lands from the State of Alaska under AS 29.65; and

WHEREAS, the City of Anderson is in the process of building a new septage facility which will benefit the health and safety of the Denali Borough citizens; and

WHEREAS, after numerous professional placement studies, the preferred location for the septage facility would be south of the Denali Borough Landfill, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has Municipal Entitlement Land just south of the Denali Landfill, and

WHEREAS, the City of Anderson requires approximately 98-acres of this land for the new septage facility, and

WHEREAS, the City of Anderson wishes to exchange approximately 98-acres of land adjacent to the Denali Borough Landfill for up to approximately 98-acres of City of Anderson land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly hereby authorizes the Denali Borough Mayor in conjunction with the City of Anderson Mayor, to initiate and expedite the exchange of the aforementioned parcels.
