A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT/PF) REMOVE THE PASSING LANES FROM MILEPOST 227 TO MILEPOST 229 IN PROJECT IM-000S(716)/63515

WHEREAS, DOT/PF Project IM-000S(716)/63515 proposes to construct numerous passing lanes along the George Parks Highway between Milepost 163 and 305; and

WHEREAS, the section between Milepost 227 and 229 is being considered for passing lanes; and

WHEREAS, the substantial number of driveways within this section creates a significant volume of local traffic exiting and entering the George Parks Highway, especially during the tourist season; and

WHEREAS, the testimony of local residents has firmly been opposed to additional passing lanes within this areas citing safety concerns which may arise with multiple lanes and maintaining a sixty five mile per hour speed limit.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Denali Borough Assembly requests that the passing lanes considered between Milepost 227 and 229 be removed from project consideration.
