RESOLUTION NO. 10-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY INSTITUTING A COMMITTEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESEARCHING, SCOPING, PLANNING, AND STEERING REGARDING A BOROUGH WIDE SYSTEM OF MULTI-USE TRAILS AND PATHWAYS.

WHEREAS, a critical, definite need for a comprehensive system of borough wide "multi use" pathways has been identified; and

WHEREAS, it is generally understood that times of economic downturn are opportune periods to improve infrastructure within governed areas; and

WHEREAS, investment in Denali Borough infrastructure is of primary importance to encourage future economic growth and stability; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of borough residents and visitors alike will be favorably impacted; and

WHEREAS, the development of this project will support and benefit the Denali Borough private, public, corporate and military sectors alike; and

WHEREAS, similar plans, which may be consolidated, are already in the works within borough communities, and

WHEREAS, there is broad support throughout the Denali Borough for this effort.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Denali Borough hereby institutes a planning/steering committee with the goal to produce a master plan and steer development of a system of multi use trails and byways throughout the borough.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: this committee shall consist of five members and shall be formed according to the following guidelines:

1. Qualifications. All members of the committee shall meet the qualifications of a voter as delineated in DBC 8.05.020.
2. Member Selection. Seat appointments shall be nominated and approved by the assembly. (Seats A thru E)
3. Term The term of this committee shall commence upon adoption of this resolution and terminate upon project completion or by assembly resolution.

4. Officers The committee will select a chairperson and vice chairperson and secretary.
5. Procedures. The committee will follow procedures contained in Chapter 2.45.040 Denali Borough Code of Ordinances and the current edition of Roberts Rules of Order.
6. Records. Minutes of all committee meetings will be kept and recorded.
7. Activity. The Committee shall act by advisory resolution to the assembly and planning commission.
8. Name. The name of this committee shall be: Denali Borough Trail-ways Committee.
9. Funding. Funding for this committee shall be provided through Denali Borough budget appropriation.
