RESOLUTION NO. 09-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING IMMEDIATE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS NEAR THE REX CROSSING OVERPASS INCLUDING 275.5-277

WHEREAS, the assembly is the governing body of the Denali Borough and is concerned about the health and safety of borough residents; and

WHEREAS, very recently it has become obvious to the assembly that severe problems near the Rex Crossing have become so hazardous that the residents using the area for local access are endangered; and

WHEREAS, the people affected, about 50, include a single mom, retired people and children catching the school bus; and

WHEREAS, building of the overpass at mile 275.5 – 277 has been completed and many promises were not fulfilled by the state including acceleration lanes, signage, guardrails on Rexanna Road and effected elevated driveways, passing zone and speed reduction signs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Denali Borough Assembly requests the above mentioned items be addressed immediately to avoid significant injury and tragic consequences to residents of the area and all using the Parks Highway.
