RESOLUTION NO. 07-38

**A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME'S CONTINUED ANTLERLESS MOOSE
HUNT IN UNIT 20A.**

WHEREAS, this hunt has gone beyond the original 3 year limit; and

WHEREAS, residents of the Denali Borough have reported seeing less and less moose over the last 4 years; and

WHEREAS, areas of the Denali Borough in unit 20A, which traditionally sustained a thriving population of moose, are now without herds; and

WHEREAS, trails in the Denali Borough have received greatly increased pressure from this hunt, resulting in destruction and impassability of many of these trails; and

WHEREAS, increased hunter pressure has resulted in a substantial negative environmental impact both from ATV damage to pristine wilderness ecosystems and large amounts of litter and trash, and


WHEREAS, the quality of life for residents of the Denali Borough has been adversely affected by continuation of this hunt, and

WHEREAS, attempts by private citizens to mitigate these problems through the Fish and Game Advisory Board have gone largely untended.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Denali Borough Assembly is in opposition to the continued antlerless moose hunt in unit 20A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Denali Borough Assembly requests the Alaska Board of Fish and Game to review the actions of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game and the Fish and Game Advisory Board concerning management of wildlife resources.
