A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY IDENTIFYING LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has identified priority items that will continue the appropriate and legitimate operation of borough functions; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough, during fiscal year 2009, invested in landfill operations and contributed to public safety throughout the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has recognized specific needs of particular functions.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Denali Borough Assembly and Administration will ask for funding from the Alaska Legislature for the following identified items, which will also include amounts requested:

1. \$330,000 for cell construction at the landfill
2. \$68,000 for a dump truck
3. \$30,000 for the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department (new well)
4. \$25,000 for the McKinley Village Volunteer Fire Department (new truck)
5. \$20,000 for the Cantwell Volunteer Fire Department (CPR vest)

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Denali Borough also supports funding requests that will be presented by the City of Anderson, a municipality located within the borough.
