A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY PRIORITIZING COMMUNITY
IMPROVEMENTS AND SAFETY ENHANCEMENT INITIATIVES WITHIN THE DENALI BOROUGH
FOR FY 2011

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough #1 priority relates to acquiring and funding the rights of way for a Borough wide multi-use trail system that interconnects with all major intersections along the Parks Highway corridor to favorably impact the health, safety and physical well-being of Borough residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough #2 priority is to petition the state legislature to legally endorse the exchange of lands between AKRR, DNR, and/or other governmental agencies, to facilitate property transfers within the Tri-Valley Subdivision, Healy, Alaska, and other similarly affected areas of the Borough to enable the selling, transferring or allocating of property to persons holding long-term leases; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough #3 priority is to continue funding the Municipal Revenue Sharing support for the elimination of PERS/TRS funding shortfalls; and


WHEREAS, the Denali Borough #4 priority is enhanced funding for Rural Alaska Community Educational funding; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough #5 priority is to continue to support the Stampede Recreational Area Bill; and

WHEREAS the Denali Borough #6 priority is to continue pursuing a career technical school and training center within the confines of the Borough.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Denali Borough Assembly authorizes Mayor Talerico to request appropriation from the legislature for the Denali Borough priorities list.
