A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONSIDER CONSTRUCTION OF SAFE TRAILS AROUND THE TRI-VALLEY SCHOOL LOCATED WITHIN THE DENALI BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough anticipated project summary 2010-2012 includes George Parks Highway upgrades from mp 163-305; and

WHEREAS, the Healy Roads chip and seal construction begins in 2011; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of the TRAAK criteria and Safe Schools meets the scope of the project; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of Safe Routes to schools benefits children and community by engaging in physical activity; and

WHEREAS, engineering safe routes addresses neighborhood to school connection and traffic control; and

WHEREAS, safe routes improves driver awareness around school zones; and

WHEREAS, safe routes encourages parents and children to walk to school by providing safe routes; and

WHEREAS, Tri-Valley subdivision has greatest concentration of students with over 200 homes in an immediate one mile area of school zone; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly appropriated \$5000 towards work for safe routes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Denali Borough Assembly approves applying for funding for safe routes to schools.
