There were no comments.



Call to Order

Deputy Presiding Officer Lee LIGHTFOOT called the regular meeting to order at 7:27 PM.

Roll Call

Planning commissioners present were: Baxter MERCER, Lee LIGHTFOOT, Susan BRAUN, Barbara BREASE, Steve JONES and Sid MICHAELS. Absent: Mark MENKE and Kesslyn TENCH. Mayor Clay Walker was present.

Public Comments

Otto Lake area resident Ivana Haverlikova stated that she is pleased to see that some of the Otto Lake area commercial operators are maintaining the road and some of the trails. However, someone removed gravel on borough land to use on the road and trails but left some large, deep holes where the gravel was removed.

Approval of Agenda

Baxter MERCER MOVED to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was second. The VOTE by show of hands was unanimous.

Approval of Minutes

Baxter MERCER MOVED to approve the public hearing and regular meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded. The VOTE by show of hands was unanimous.

Correspondence

State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Public Use Determination on easement held by Denali ATV Adventures:

The commission discussed the State Department of Natural Resources determination that the easement, located near Dry Creek off the George Parks Highway, held by Denali ATV Adventures, is a private easement which does not grant the public access and allows Denali ATV Adventures the right to block access along the easement route.

United States of America, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission re: Request for Comments on the Alternative Route for the Alaska LNG Project:

The commission discussed this proposed alternative route and decided to provide no comment because the assembly already submitted a supportive resolution.

- 12 • The process continues with the selection of lands to be conveyed from AHTNA, Inc. to
- 13 the community of Cantwell to satisfy the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act 14(C)3
- 14 requirement.
- 15 • Alaska Department of Natural Resources representatives, AJ Wait and David Hite, came
- 16 to the borough office to discuss land issues including a communication site near
- 17 McKinley Village and the recent determination that management of State approved
- 18 rights-of-way within the Denali Borough should be managed by the Denali Borough.
- 19 • The assembly passed a resolution in support of a project to repave the Healy airport.
- 20 • Title 4 remains on the assembly agenda.
- 21 • The assembly approved funding to retain the consulting firm Agnew::Beck to provide
- 22 process options for the development of a Denali Borough Land Use Plan.

41 Sid MICHAELS MOVED to postpone to the next work session, public hearing, and regular

42 meeting as Denali Borough Code Chapter 9.10 Draft 2. The motion was seconded. The VOTE

43 by show of hands was unanimous.

2 **New Business**

3 **PC Resolution 16-07, Alaska Railroad Land Lease to Central Monofill Services, Inc.**

4 Baxter MERCER MOVED to postpone indefinitely. The motion was seconded. The VOTE by
5 show of hands was 5 to 1 with Sid MICHAELS opposed.

6
7 **Public Comments**

8 Otto Lake resident Ivana Haverlikova encouraged the planning commission to establish
9 standards and regulations for commercial operators that operate on borough land,
10 especially operators that utilize roads and trails on borough lands.

11
12 **Commissioner Comments**

13 Sid MICHAELS offered his resignation from the planning commission. He stated that he
14 believes he will have more freedom to express his opposition to the potential Alaska Railroad
15 land lease to Central Monofill Services, Inc. as a citizen of the borough and not as a
16 commissioner. This belief is due to the Denali Borough legal counsel recommendation that
17 assembly members, planning commissioners, and employees refrain from taking a stance,
18 prior to the public hearing process as described in Denali Borough Code, on this potential
19 project.

20
21 Susan BRAUN stated that she is sorry to see Mr. MICHAELS resign from the commission.

22
23 Barbara BREASE stated that she has learned so much from Mr. MICHAELS and she is sorry to
24 see him resign from the commission. She asked how the borough will investigate the report of
25 gravel removal holes in the Otto lake area on borough land?

26
27 Steve JONES stated that we need to make sure enforcement measures are described in Title 4
28 to address situations like gravel removal holes being left on borough land.

29
30 Baxter MERCER commented that trails throughout the borough are deteriorating. He stated
31 that he will miss Mr. MICHAELS on the commission but he understands the reason for his
32 resignation.

33
34 Lee LIGHTFOOT stated that he will miss Mr. MICHAELS on the commission and has enjoyed his
35 contributions. He reported that most road and easement standards also include trail standards
36 and the commission can consider that as they work through road and easement standards in
37 future meetings. Mr. LIGHTFOOT thanked everyone for attending the meeting.

40 Susan BRAUN offered to attend the October assembly meeting and provide the planning
41 commission report.
