PROPOSITION NO. 1:

Section 9.17 of the Denali Borough Charter establishes a permanent investment fund. The principal of the fund is maintained separately from other Borough funds, but all income from the fund must be deposited in the Borough's general fund. Money in the general fund may be spent for any lawful purpose.

Ordinance 92-02 would amend the Charter so that one half of the income must be retained in the permanent investment fund. The other half of the income would be retained in the fund unless it is appropriated for other purposes by ordinance.

Ordinance 92-02 would also amend the Charter to require that every disbursement of money from the principal of the permanent investment fund (1) must be authorized by an ordinance and approved by the voters at an election, (2) must be used for a single specific purpose, and (3) must be returned to the fund if not actually spent for that purpose.

Ordinance 92-02 will take effect only if it is approved by a majority of the votes cast at this election.

Shall Ordinance No. 92-02 be approved?
