*Tipping fees are set by non-code ordinances per 6.15.070(B). Fee increases will have a minimum effective date of six months from introduction of the ordinance.

Bed level to halfway up cab	2 cubic yards = \$30.00	3 cubic yards = \$45.00
Halfway up cab to top of cab	3 cubic yards = \$45.00	4 cubic yards = \$60.00
FREON containing appliances	\$50.00	
Residential Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – such as oil, paints, solvents	Free	
Handling Fee for the Recycling of TV's, Computers, and Mattresses ***	\$15.00 per unit	
Fluorescent Light Bulbs ****	\$0.15 per bulb	

** Bags sized above 32 gallons will be charged as cubic yardage.

*** More than two computers or TVs per load should go to the landfill @ \$15.00 per unit

**** Limit 10 bulbs – more than 10 should go to the landfill for \$0.15 per bulb.

Measuring and calculating formula for trailers or other odd, shaped beds:

Length x Width x Height in feet divided by 27 to obtain cubic yardage, then multiply by \$15.
