*Tipping fees are set by non-code ordinances per 6.15.070(B). Fee increases will have a minimum effective date of six months from introduction of the ordinance.

Measuring and calculating formula for trailers or other odd, shaped beds:

Length x Width x Height in feet divided by 27 to obtain cubic yardage, then multiply by \$15.

**More than two computers or TV's per load should go to the landfill \$15.00 per unit.
