PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS AWARDED

Alaska DOT's Transportation Alternatives Program funds small-scale projects for pedestrians, bicycles, ADA facilities, and community improvements.

190 projects were submitted, 18 projects are receiving funding, including a project in the Denali Borough! The award will fund a roadside pedestrian path radiating out from the Tri-Valley School and along the highway to the Antler Ridge trailhead.

This represents over a \$6 million investment into our community, with funds coming from federal, state, and local commitments.
