**ORDINANCE NO. 17-10**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF AN ADDITIONAL UP TO \$50,000  
FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO AN  
EXTENSION OF THE LANDFILL SHOP BUILDING**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Background.** The Denali Borough entered into an agreement with the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development in June 2012, for a new landfill shop grant (13-DM-223) in the amount of \$50,000.

The Denali Borough Assembly passed Ordinance 16-03 in February 2016, appropriating up to \$310,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund to construct an extension to the landfill shop.

**Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate additional funds to build an extension of the existing landfill shop building. This additional appropriation will cover unforeseen project change orders, necessary existing shop electrical upgrades, and shop extension electrical work.

**Section 4. Appropriation – Source and Amount.** The Denali Borough Assembly appropriates up to \$50,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund.

**Section 5. Procedure.** The project will be completed in accordance with Denali Borough Code 3.35, titled "Procurement, Procedures, and Contracting Standards."

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and the signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
