ORDINANCE NO. 17-15

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$62,600 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR
REIMBURSABLE EXPENDITURES RELATED TO STATE HOMELAND SECURITY
PROGRAM GRANT**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to approve and accept 2017 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant funds and to appropriate up to \$62,600 from the General Fund for reimbursable expenditures related to this grant. Eligible expenditures include hydraulic spreader, hydraulic cutter, hydraulic ram, cribbing and struts. Purchased equipment will be transferred to McKinley Village and Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Departments.

Section 3. Granting Agency. SHSP grants are funded by the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management through the State of Alaska to support, build, and sustain the ability of states to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks and other all-hazards events.

Section 4. Requirements. No funds will be reimbursed until Borough representatives attend a 2017 Grant Kick-Off Meeting. SHSP recipients are required to submit timely quarterly progress reports.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
