

**DENALI BOROUGH, ALASKA
ORDINANCE 20-11
INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR CLAY WALKER**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$46,000 FROM THE PARKS AND RECREATION FUND TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED MATCH AND THE CONTINGENCY MATCH AMOUNTS FOR PHASES ONE AND TWO OF THE HEALY SPUR ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Section 1. Classification.

This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. This appropriation of funds provides the Denali Borough's matching contribution of 9.03% of phases one and two of the Healy Spur Road Improvement Project, which includes additional new wide shoulders to accommodate pedestrian and bicycle traffic. This project was accepted for award by the Community Transportation Program Project Evaluation Board in April 2020. Phases three and four will require an additional match of up to \$130,000, at a later date.

Section 3. Appropriation – Source and Amount.

The Denali Borough Assembly appropriates up to \$46,000 from the Parks and Recreation Fund for Community Transportation Program project of Healy Spur Road Improvements, including additional wide shoulders for increased pedestrian and bicycle accommodation.

Section 4. Procedure.

The appropriation will be completed in accordance with Denali Borough Code 5.55.30, titled "Parks and Recreation Fund."

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and the signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
