**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$55,000 FROM THE
EMERGENCY RESPONSE APPARATUS FUND TOWARDS THE
PURCHASE OF A TRACKED UTV FOR THE ANDERSON FIRE
DEPARTMENT AND A WATER TENDER FOR THE TRI-VALLEY
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate up to \$55,000 from the Emergency Response Apparatus Fund as the Borough's matching contribution towards the purchase of a tracked UTV for the Anderson Fire Department and a Water Tender for the Tri-Valley Fire Department.

Section 3. Procedure. The Anderson Volunteer Fire Department and the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department will secure the additional funds needed to complete the apparatus purchase. The Denali Borough shall reimburse funds upon receipt of the apparatus or provide direct vendor pay upon request.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective July 1, 2021. The Anderson Volunteer Fire Department and the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department have three years from the effective date to utilize these funds. Any unspent funds beyond three years of the effective date will lapse into the emergency apparatus fund as available, un-committed funds.
