ORDINANCE NO. 23-09  
INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR CLAY WALKER**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$55,000 FROM THE MAJOR  
SCHOOL MAINTENANCE FUND TO RECONSTRUCT AND EXPAND  
THE OUTDOOR BASKETBALL COURT AT TRI-VALLEY SCHOOL**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Background.** The current Denali Borough Capital Improvement Program identifies “outdoor recreation and parking improvements on the north side of Tri-Valley School” as a priority. The existing half-court basketball court has deteriorated to a state which necessitates reconstruction. Suitable space exists to expand from a half court to a full court facility.

An asphalt plant is erected in the vicinity of the project currently and the contractor has provided a quote for reclaiming existing material, excavation, subgrade, borrow, base course and 2 inches of asphalt for a full basketball court area totaling under \$50,000, which includes no mobilization costs.

The Major School Maintenance Fund currently holds \$109,000 in the checking account and \$655,000 in a money market fund. There are currently no foreseen expenditures from this fund in FY 24.

**Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to accomplish a portion of an approved CIP project (outdoor recreation upgrades on the north side of Tri Valley School) in an economical manner due to proximity of materials and equipment.

Section 4. Appropriation. The Denali Borough Assembly appropriates up to \$55,000 from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund for the purpose of the reconstruction of the Tri Valley School outdoor recreation facility.


**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance is effective upon approval.
