AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$369,778.50 FROM THE PARKS AND RECREATION FUND USING LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND TRIBAL CONSISTENCY FUNDS FOR THE LOCAL MATCH CONTRIBUTION OF THE HEALY SPUR ROAD TO ANTLER RIDGE PEDESTRIAN PATH PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification.

This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Background.

The Denali Borough received a Memorandum of Agreement from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities in July 2024 for the Healy Spur Road to Antler Ridge Pedestrian Path project in the amount of \$4,300,000 with a total local participating share in the amount of \$369,778.50.

Section 3. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate the local match contribution of \$369,778.50 from the Parks and Recreation Fund using Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds (LATCF) for the Healy Spur Road to Antler Ridge Pedestrian Path project.

Section 4. Procedures.

This project will be completed in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement for this project, and the laws of the State of Alaska.

Section 5. Effective Date.


This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
