ORDINANCE NO. 24-11

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$20,750 FROM THE
MAJOR SCHOOL MAINTENANCE RESERVE FUND TO COMPLETE
THE FUNDING PACKAGE FOR A REPLACEMENT BACK-UP
GENERATOR AT TRI-VALLEY SCHOOL**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Background. The current Capital Improvement Programs of both the Denali Borough and the Denali Borough School District identify the need to replace the back-up generator at Tri-Valley School. The current generator is original and over 35 years old. Replacement parts are not available, and the generator has proven to be unreliable in times of need.

The borough's application for grant funding a portion of this project through the State of Alaska Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management's State Homeland Security Program was recently approved. The borough is set to receive \$123,750 from this project on a reimbursable basis.

Working with the district's Facilities Manager, the recent cost estimate for the entire project is \$247,500. This project is not eligible for the Department of Education and Early Development's Major School Maintenance Grant Program.


Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to allocate additional borough funds from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund to complete the funding package for a necessary facility upgrade – replacing the original generator at Tri-Valley School

Section 4. Appropriation. The Denali Borough Assembly appropriates an additional \$20,750 from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund, in addition to the \$103,000 allocated through Ordinance 23-22, to complete the funding package for the replacement back-up generator project at Tri-Valley School.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective upon approval.
