AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$200,000 FROM THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE APPARATUS FUND TOWARDS THE TRI-VALLEY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT PURCHASE OF AN ENGINE-FIRE TRUCK.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

<u>Section 1. Classification</u>. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

<u>Section 2. Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate up to \$200,000 from the Emergency Response Apparatus Fund as the Borough's matching contribution towards the purchase of an Engine-Fire Truck for the Tri-Valley Fire Department.

<u>Section 3. Procedure.</u> The Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department will secure the additional funds needed to complete the purchase of the Engine-Fire Truck. The Denali Borough shall reimburse funds to the Tri-Valley Fire Department upon receipt of the ambulance or provide direct vendor pay upon request.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date.</u> This ordinance becomes effective upon approval.
