**ORDINANCE NO. 24-17**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE UP TO \$180,000  
FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR REIMBURSABLE EXPENDITURES  
RELATED TO THE OTTO LAKE VAULTED TOILET FACILITY PROJECT**

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to accept FY 2025 Designated Legislative Grant funds for the purpose of constructing a vaulted toilet facility at the Otto Lake Park in the amount of \$180,000 and to appropriate up to \$180,000 from the General Fund for expenditures related to this project. Eligible expenditures include contractual and material costs associated with this project.

**Section 3. Granting Agency.** The Designated Legislative Grant Program is funded by the State of Alaska through the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Community and Regional Affairs.

**Section 4. Requirements.** Designated Legislative Grant Program recipients are required to manage the awarded project and provide reports according to the grant award agreement.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
