ORDINANCE NO. 15-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE DENALI BOROUGH DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE SAME AND APPROPRIATING THE NET PROCEEDS TO THE SOLID WASTE EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND

BE IT ENACTED BY THE Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that;

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to sell and remove surplus property in conformity with Section 9.14 of the Denali Borough Charter. The administration is hereby authorized to post notice and sell said surplus property.

Section 3. Property. The following equipment is identified as surplus property with the minimum bid price listed:

1993 Ford L9000 Dump Truck	\$17,500
1979 John Deere 644B Loader	\$4,500

Section 4. Finance. The net proceeds of the sale of said property shall be appropriated to the Solid Waste Equipment Reserve Fund.

Section 5. Conveyance. All property will be sold as is, where is, and the purchaser will be responsible for the removal of said property within a reasonable time as determined by the administration. A waiver of release will be required prior to a buyer removing the equipment.


Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
