RESOLUTION NO. 19-14**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HJR 10, SPONSORED BY
REPRESENTATIVE TALERICO, A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE
DEVELOPMENT OF A ROAD BELT ELECTRICAL INTER-TIE
TRANSMISSION LINE**

WHEREAS, HJR 10, under consideration by the Alaska Legislature, urges Congress to advocate for the security of the nation's northernmost military and energy infrastructure by pursuing the development of the Road Belt Inter-tie; and

WHEREAS, the Road Belt Inter-tie would create a high-voltage electrical line running from Sutton to Glenallen, where a sub-transmission line would extend to Gakona and on to Tok and north through the upper Tanana region to Delta Junction, and the final leg of the project would run from near Delta Junction, just south of Fort Greely, back to Gulkana; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports infrastructure development for energy and national security, economic development, and natural resource development in the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, this development would complete an electrical transmission bus loop and establish a second path for power transmission from Anchorage to Fairbanks, which is needed during disasters such as earthquakes; and

WHEREAS, this project would help meet the increased need for power at Clear Air Force Station.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly supports HJR 10 and Representative Talerico's efforts to improve the energy supply and security of our region.
