## DENALI BOROUGH, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 18-01

### A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY IDENTIFYING A STATE OF ALASKA CAPITAL BUDGET REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough has assumed solid waste powers; and

**WHEREAS**, the borough currently operates a Class 2 Municipal Solid Waste Landfill at MP 282.5 of the Parks Highway and a transfer station at MP 213; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding provided by Village Safe Water in the late 1990s to build these facilities was intended to also build a transfer station in Healy, the largest community in the borough, located at MP 248; and

**WHEREAS**, due to project funding shortfalls, the Healy transfer station was never built; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough has prioritized this project through our Capital Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the borough undertook an extensive planning process resulting in the identification and classification of a site location on borough owned land near MP 252; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough Assembly has procured full site development plans and 100% design of the proposed new facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough Assembly has allocated monies for development of the site including clearing, grading, construction of an access road, gravel pad, retaining wall, fencing and more; and

**WHEREAS**, borough capital monies are fully spent on this development, leaving a need for a gatehouse, containers, and a recycling structure for this facility to be operational; and

**WHEREAS**, this new facility will benefit not only the local population, but also the great number of traveling public through the Denali area and seasonal workers.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Denali Borough Assembly and Administration requests the State of Alaska contribute to this effort in the form of a Legislative Grant of \$140,000 to construct a gatehouse and a recycling shelter, as well as procure containers.
