DENALI BOROUGH, ALASKA DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 19-20

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE DENALI BOROUGH TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (ADOT&PF) FOR THE COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FOR THE HEALY AREA PEDESTRIAN PATH PROJECT IN DENALI BOROUGH AND AUTHORIZING CLAY WALKER, MAYOR, TO SIGN THE APPLICATION AND FUTURE PROJECT AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has received a request from the ADOT&PF to nominate projects for inclusion in the Alaska Community Transportation Program funds as outlined in ADOT&PF's application packet for 2020-2023; and,

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough is participating as an eligible project sponsor in the ADOT&PF Community Transportation Program; and,

WHEREAS, federal monies are available under a Community Transportation Program, administered by ADOT&PF, for the purpose of creating and promoting the planning and development of transportation projects in Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough acknowledges availability of the required match of no less than 9.03%; and,

WHEREAS, after appropriate public input and due consideration, the governing body of Denali Borough has recommended that an application be submitted to the State of Alaska for the Healy Area Pedestrian Path project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Denali Borough Assembly:

Section 1.

That the Denali Borough does hereby authorize Clay Walker, Mayor, to submit and sign an application to the ADOT&PF for Community Transportation Program funds on behalf of the citizens of the Denali Borough.

Section 2.

That the Denali Borough hereby assures the ADOT&PF that sufficient funding for the Denali Borough matching contribution for the Healy Area Pedestrian Path project is available.

Section 3.

That the Denali Borough hereby assures the ADOT&PF that the Denali Borough will commit to ownership/management and maintenance and operations responsibilities and that sufficient funding for the Healy Area Shared Path project will be available for the life of the project.

Section 4.

That the Assembly of the Denali Borough supports the project entitled Healy Area Shared Path and agrees, subject to available STIP funding and programming by ADOT&PF, to enter into a memorandum of agreement with the State of Alaska DOT&PF, in accordance with 17 AAC 05.175(I), for the design, construction, transfer, or maintenance of a STIP project pertaining to the Healy Area Pedestrian Path.
