**A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY RECOMMENDING
FUNDING FOR THE EMERGENCY SERVICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY GRANT
PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.**

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has provided an Emergency Services and Public Safety Grant Program through Denali Borough Code 3.21.231; and

WHEREAS, the assembly may award reimbursable grant funding to eligible nonprofit emergency services and public safety organizations annually; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic severely impacted borough revenue; and

WHEREAS, the assembly held a Grant Review Meeting on March 31, 2021 in which the assembly reviewed all grant applications, including all Nonprofit Grant applications; and

WHEREAS, the assembly reviewed budget actuals and projections for fiscal years 2021 and 2022; and

WHEREAS, the assembly determined that preservation of borough funds is imperative and that borough funds should be prioritized to support borough operations, school operations and emergency services.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Denali Borough Assembly, by this resolution, hereby recommends the following Emergency Services and Public Safety Grant Funding be awarded to the following eligible organizations in Fiscal Year 2022:

Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department =	\$215,000
McKinley Volunteer Fire Department =	\$ 19,900
Denali Emergency Services Association =	\$ 71,508
Cantwell Volunteer Fire Department =	\$ 15,812.59
