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DENALI BOROUGH, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 22-27

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND TRIBAL CONSISTENCY FUNDS FROM U.S. TREASURY AND STATING AN INTENTION OF USE

WHEREAS, as part of the 2021 American Rescue Plan, U.S. Congress directed U.S. Treasury to allocate \$1.5 billion over the course of federal fiscal years 2022 and 2023 to eligible revenue sharing counties in order to “support a strong and equitable recovery” from the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Treasury considered allocation recommendations based upon current PILT (Department of Interior’s Payment In Lieu of Taxes program) payments provided by the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, in August 2022, U.S. Treasury released guidance for the use of these funds which stated, “recipients may treat these funds in a similar manner to how they treat funds generated from their own revenue” and “directs that recipients may use funds for any governmental purpose other than a lobbying activity”; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2022, U.S. Treasury announced the allocations for all revenue sharing counties and immediately opened an application portal to apply for these funds – immediately for FY22 tranche and beginning in January 2023 for the FY23 tranche; and


WHEREAS, the allocation for the Denali Borough was identified as \$955,800 to be split over two tranches of \$477,900; and

WHEREAS, another characteristic of this federal funding is that it is allowed to be used as the “non-federal match” required of so many active and upcoming grant programs; and


WHEREAS, the Denali Borough intends to maximize the potential benefit to our community by utilizing these funds to meet match requirements for in-progress and upcoming project match requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Denali Borough Assembly accepts \$955,800 in Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds and affirms an intent to amplify the community benefits through usage as match funds for identified grant-funded projects, which will require additional Assembly approvals and allocations.
