**A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING  
PROJECTS FOR THE STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION  
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) NEEDS LIST**

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough Assembly is the governing body of the Denali Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough has been advised by the state of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) that the Statewide Transportation Improvements Program (STIP) Needs List is being updated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough Planning Commission approved the list of projects included below; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denali Borough Assembly has reviewed the projects and supports the following STIP Needs List projects within the Denali Borough:

**PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL LINKAGE (PEL) Projects**

Confirm our full support of the 18 unfunded PEL projects along the Parks Highway, in full or in part (turning lanes prioritized even if bridge upgrades and pedestrian improvements aren't possible for different reconstruction projects):

- Parks Highway MP 234 - 238 Parks Hwy Reconstruction and Railroad Realignment (alt 1)
- Parks Highway MP 238 - 239 Reconstruction (Stage 1)
- Parks Highway MP 239 - 240 Nenana Canyon Rockfall Mitigation (Stage 2)
- Parks Highway MP 247 - 250 Healy Reconstruction and Pedestrian Improvements
- Parks Highway MP 250 - 260 Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 209 - 212 Cantwell Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 212 - 214 Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 215 - 224 Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 225 - 229 Resurfacing
- Parks Highway MP 229 - 230 McKinley Village Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 232 - 234 Resurfacing
- Parks Highway MP 239 - 243 Nenana Canyon Reconstruction (Stage 3)
- Parks Highway MP 243 - 247 Reconstruction
- Parks Highway MP 202 - 206 Resurfacing
- Parks Highway MP 214 - 215 Resurfacing
- Parks Highway MP 224 - 225 Carlo Creek Reconstruction

Confirm our full support for the five community connector paths, whether in the full segments identified below, or in part:

- Parks Highway Cantwell to Carlo Creek Separated Path Community Connector
- Parks Highway Carlo Creek to Crabbies Crossing Separated Path Community Connector
- Parks Highway Crabbies to Denali Park Entrance Separated Path Community Connector
- Parks Highway Denali Park Entrance to Healy Separated Path Community Connector
- Parks Highway Healy to Stampede Road Separated Path Community Connector

**Previous Project Submissions Not Included on STIP Needs List**

- Anderson turning lane at Parks Highway MP 285 to increase winter safety
- A frontage road on the west side of the Parks Highway heading south from Hilltop to alleviate any more driveways being permitted off the Parks Highway.

**Other**

- Shoulder widening for main paved residential roads: Otto Lake Road, Lignite Road, Stampede Road

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Denali Borough Assembly supports the above mentioned projects and supports inclusion of these projects into the STIP needs list.
