A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 113 (SB
60) CREATING THE STAMPEDE STATE RECREATION AREA

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly has previously passed resolutions supporting the creation of the Stampede State Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, these resolutions outlined important reasons that the Stampede State Recreation Area would be valuable to residents of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the proposed recreation area would preserve and maintain traditional recreation opportunities and provide a management structure; and

WHEREAS, this area has been recognized as unique and important for public recreation and wildlife habitat; and

WHEREAS, currently, House Bill 113 and Senate Bill 60 are available for consideration within their respective bodies resource committees.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Denali Borough Assembly requests that the Alaska State Legislature move expeditiously to pass a bill to establish the Stampede State Recreation Area.
