RESOLUTION NO. 17-02

**A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY  
SUPPORTING A SITE RECOMMENDATION FOR THE PROPOSED  
HEALY SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION LOCATION**

WHEREAS, while the Borough Assembly has passed a number of resolutions in support of a Healy Transfer Station, no location has ever been agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 15-06, the Assembly requested the Mayor to proceed with identifying a suitable location; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Planning Commission was engaged in this effort, holding six monthly public hearings on the topic and also holding one Open House; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 15-04, the Planning Commission identified three possible locations they support; and

WHEREAS, considerations such as development costs, security of investment, land use costs, site control, public roadway safety and impacts, and transfer travel time have led to a recommendation for a preferred location of the three identified; and

WHEREAS, that location is near MP 253, north of Panguingue Creek, a site which includes an existing material site; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly, at their December 2016 meeting, received the Best Estimate Fiscal Impact for this development.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Denali Borough Assembly supports the selection of the identified MP 253 site for the development of a Healy Solid Waste Transfer Station and requests the administration proceed with further planning efforts including site development planning and classifying this borough-owned land for this purpose.
